

MNCH service delivery

- **KEY ISSUES IDENTIFIED AND WAY FORWARD**
- **Infrastructure and basic facilities**
 - Rehabilitation and upgrading of health facilities with emphasis on water, electricity and sewage system.
 - Issues of functionality of health facilities
 - Range and quality of services to be provided
 - **NOTE:**
 - Government is currently rehabilitating and equipping four General hospitals and a second phase is being planned.
 - Drugs have also been procured and distributed free as part of the free MNCH programme.
 - Contract for the equipping of facilities will be signed in due course.

MNCH ... cont

- **Budgetary provision for the MNCH and rehabilitation plans. (Ministry of Budget has offered to support)**
- **Standardization of renovations and equipment**
- **Strategic plan and its linkage to YOSERA**

WAY FORWARD on MNCH

- ***Develop and adopt a Minimum Service Package (MSP) for the state***
- ***Costing of MNCH services***
- ***Technical assistance for standardization of renovation of basic infrastructure, equipment and manpower linked to MSP***
- ***Support the take off of SIACC***

 - HR audit conducted and analysis ongoing.
 - HRIS being developed
- **Filling of vacant post**

- *Conscious effort to strengthen and accreditation of the School of Nursing, Damaturu and School of Health Technology, Nguru through filling staff gap at the School of Nursing.*
